

RARSfest 2010

The Raleigh Amateur Radio Society invites you to be part of our 2010 Hamfest. The Thirty-eighth Annual RARSfest, NCS ARRL Convention and Huge Electronic Fleamarket will be held on April 3, 2010 in the Exposition Center Building, on the NC State Fairgrounds, on Hillsborough Street in Raleigh. The Expo Center Building offers 50,000 square feet to contain ALL the hamfest activities.

To remind you of some of our special features:

o FREE PARKING. Enter Gate #4, on Youth Center Drive on the West side of the Fairgrounds, off Hillsborough St. Radio talk-in: 146.04/146.64 with backup on 146.28/146.88. Easy setup: drive to your area and unload Friday 3pm to 10pm and Saturday 6am to 7:30am. All vehicles must then leave the building.

o Security on duty at all times inside and outside the building

o Dealer Booths available with table, chairs, divider curtains and electricity. Additional booth tables are available at cost. See Page 2 for details. Please bring your own power cords, distribution boxes and moving carts.

o All activities are held under one roof; no outside selling is allowed. NO FOOD, DRINK or WEAPONS may be sold or donated by attendees in the hamfest building. Also, NO ANIMALS are allowed in the hamfest building on hamfest day.

o Plenty of Recreational Vehicle space is available with full hookups. The \$25/night fee will be collected by Fairgrounds Authorities. Motels are not far away. Red Roof Inn (919)469-3400; Fairfield Inn Crabtree (919)881-9081; Hampton Inn- Crabtree (919)782-1112.

o Food Concession is in the hamfest building.

o Welcoming Supper - Please accept our invitation to join us at Friday night, 7-8pm, in the Hamfest Building.

The RARSfest is the only non-professional show for electronic enthusiasts in the Raleigh area. Thank you for registering to attend the 38th Annual RARSfest!

The following information is presented to help you have an even better time.

- * The setup times for all are Friday, April 2, 3pm to 10pm and Saturday, April 3, 6 to 7:30am. ALL vehicles must be out of the building by 10pm and 7:30am respectively. Hamfest hours are Saturday, 8am to 3:30pm.
- * Drive in through Gate #4 on Youth Center Rd, which runs between Hillsborough St. and Trinity Rd. on the West side of the Fairgrounds. Park in the area on the West Side or North sides the Exposition Center(hamfest) Building, outside the entrance to the Fleamarket. Free Parking.
- * RV/Camper parking is welcome in designated areas and Fairgrounds authorities will collect the \$25 per night fee at your site. Info: <http://www.ncstatefair.org/facilities/rvaccess.htm>
- * Please bring all your own moving CARTS and POWER extension cords.
- * NO FOOD, DRINKS, WEAPONS or PORNOGRAPHIC MATERIALS are allowed to be sold or donated in the hamfest building.
- * There will be NO SMOKING and NO ANIMALS in the Hamfest building.
- * There will be the WELCOMING PARTY/SUPPER for all Friday night, 7 to 8pm, in the Foyer in the front of the hamfest building. Please join us!
- * Security will be provided in and around the Hamfest building all during setup, overnight and through hamfest closing time.
- * If help is needed go to the Information Booth next to the stage. Remember the Food Concession is in the Expo Building.
- * Please be patient in leaving the hamfest after 3:30pm. Vehicles will not be allowed to enter until after this time.
- * No transmitting on HF except to a dummy load and a maximum of 5 Watts on higher frequencies. The Exception will be for the Special Events Station, N4C.
- * Alternative activities available in the area include the Fairgrounds General Fleamarket outside the Hamfest Building, NC Museum of Art, and the Blue Ridge Cinema. Crabtree Valley Mall is a short drive away; see the map on flyer or on www.rars.org/hamfest
